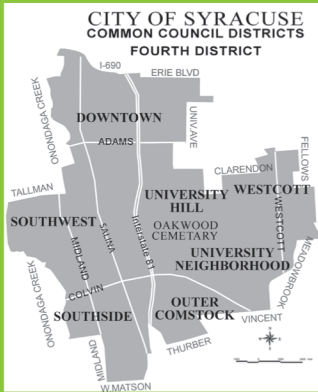
### Use Your Ballot for Positive Change
